



# LIFT JESUS HIGHER RALLY

## Key Details for Vendors

To make the Lift Jesus Higher Rally a great day for all who attend, we ask that vendors and exhibitors abide by these guidelines. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out to the Rally Team at [ljhr@renewalministries.net](mailto:ljhr@renewalministries.net).

1. The Rally will take place on Saturday, March 14, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM.
2. Exhibitors and vendors are invited to setup booths as follows:
  - a. Adult Rally: Setup begins at 7:00 AM.
  - b. Youth Rally: Setup begins at 7:45 AM.
3. All vendor table spaces and locations are pre-designated and cannot be changed on the day of the event.
4. An 8-foot table and two chairs will be provided for each vendor or exhibitor.
5. Be prepared for significant crowds during all break periods. The schedule, with exact break times, will be sent two weeks prior to the Rally and will be available in the Rally Program that will be distributed on Rally day.
6. Please refrain from selling or talking during Eucharistic Adoration and Holy Mass.
7. As all are encouraged to attend the sessions and there is no selling during Eucharistic Adoration and Holy Mass, please bring a sheet or table cloth to cover your exhibitor table when your booth is not staffed.
8. It is best to park on Level 4A of the MTCC garage. From the garage, take the elevator to the 100 level and proceed to Constitution Hall. If you enter from Front Street, take the escalator or elevator #5 to the 100 level. *Please note that you will not be allowed to use the escalator if you have boxes, dollies, or carts.*

Information from Metro Toronto Convention Centre:

1. Regulations prohibit the insertion of nails, screws, hooks, and pushpins, or the use of unapproved tape on walls or floors.
2. Per the Fire Marshall, all solicitation must take place at your table. Handing out flyers, brochures, or other free items must happen at your table, not in corridors, or walkways.
3. Power, internet, telecommunications, and parking must be pre-arranged through Metro Toronto Convention Centre.
